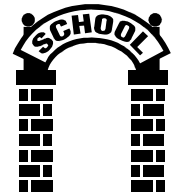

## Kindergarten Registration 2016/17 & Ready, Set, Learn Event



Kindergarten registration for September 2016 at Beach Grove Elementary begins Wednesday, February 17<sup>th</sup> starting at 9:00 am. This is scheduled on the same day as our Ready, Set, Learn event and we invite you to join us with your preschooler in the gym at 9:15 a.m. Mr. Matt Jamieson, a retired Delta teacher will be doing a sing-a-long and storytelling with the children. Mrs. West-Sells and Mrs. Hansen, our Kindergarten teachers will also talk to parents about preparing their child for kindergarten.

A child may be registered to attend Kindergarten in September 2016 if his or her fifth birthday occurs on or before December 31, 2016.

Please bring the following documentation when you come to register:

- Child's birth certificate or passport (**registration will not be accepted until proof of birth date is received**)
- Proof of citizenship for both the parent and the student (Canadian birth certificate, citizenship card, passport, landed immigrant document, permanent resident card)
- Record of immunization, care card, medical and emergency contact information
- Appropriate proof of residency (Property Taxes- current receipt, purchase/rental agreement or rental receipt).

**You must register your child at his/her catchment area school.** If you are not sure of your catchment area school, please call Mrs. Adam in the school office at 604 943 0108 to verify.

## **Non-catchment Forms Available from the School Office**

School Choice legislation enables parents to apply to any Delta school. However, there are procedures in place that protect spaces for catchment area students in their home school. If you know of any families who would like their child(ren) to attend Beach Grove next year but do not live in our catchment area, please pass this information on to them.

Non-catchment forms are also available from the school office for the 2016/2017 school year. The earliest these completed forms can be submitted is February 1<sup>st</sup>.

This is for all grades, including Kindergarten. For students registering for grades 1-7, these forms are to be submitted to the requested school. **For Kindergarten students, these Non-catchment forms are to be given to the catchment area school.**
