Year-End Assemblies - Everyone Welcome!

We will be having two year-end assemblies at Beach Grove this year.

The first will be held on **Wednesday, June 24th at 2:15 p.m.** This will be a "Farewell Assembly" to honour the staff and students who will be leaving us. We will be showing the "Grade 7 Year End" slide show (a presentation which highlights the various Grade 7 activities throughout the year) to all students at this assembly. The slide show will also be running at the beginning of the assembly on June 25th for parents to view.



On **Thursday, June 25th** from 9:00 to 10:30 a.m. we will hold our traditional Grade 7 Celebration assembly. At this final assembly of the year we will be recognizing the outstanding achievements made by some of our grade seven students and saying farewell to them all. Seating will be available for parents; however the front section of chairs will be reserved for the parents of grade seven students. At the assembly you will have an opportunity to help us send our grade sevens on to the next phase of their education. Students will be issued their final reports on June 27th after the year-end assembly and dismissed at approximately **10:15 a.m.**

School will resume on Tuesday, Sept. 8th. This will be a half-day, with students attending from 8:45 to 12:18 pm. Students may be able to move straight into their new classes or they may be in grade groups on the first day. New registrations and withdrawals over the summer may require us to reorganize our tentative assignments for both students and teachers.
