Student Placement Request Form

The placement of students for the upcoming school year is a decision of great importance and something that teachers consider very carefully. Your child’s present teacher, along with other staff members who work with your child, have a year’s worth of current, rich information and insight about the conditions under which your child learns best. If you have information about your child and about the kind of learning environment in which she/he best works and learns and you would like to share this information with our staff, please fill in the “Parent Information Form” below.

It is important to note that it is not possible for parents to choose their child’s teacher. Teachers who are currently on staff may not be here next year, may not be assigned the same grade, or may not teach a class configuration that meets your child’s learning needs.

All the information submitted will be considered but there are **no guarantees** that we can accommodate your request.

As preliminary decisions about next year’s classes will soon be made, you are asked to ***return the completed form no later than Friday, May 27th***. Please keep in mind that this information will be shared with all staff members and considered when the class lists are finally confirmed.
