Report Cards

Term 1 Report Cards will be sent home Wednesday, December 20th.

Assessment, evaluation and reporting are integral components of the teaching-learning process. The purpose of assessment, evaluation and reporting is to enhance and support student learning.

- **Assessment** involves the systematic gathering of information in order to describe what students know, are able to do, and are working toward.
- Evaluation involves the analysis, synthesis and interpretation of the assessment information based upon those standards as mandated learning outcomes. These learning outcomes outline what students need to know and should be able to do in particular curricular areas.
- **Reporting** is the consultative process of clearly and concisely communicating to parents how well students have achieved the learning outcomes in their educational programs.

This year in both Primary and Intermediate grades, students do not receive letter grades. Children's progress is reported in relation to the prescribed learning outcomes for each grade. These expectations are general statements about children's development and learning over time. They take into account children's knowledge, experience and interest in an integrated curriculum.

All formal reports describe:

- what students are able to do;
- the areas in which students require further attention; and
- ways to support students in their learning.

A new component of our pilot report cards is the addition of the student self assessment piece. Be sure to talk to your child about what they are learning and how they feel about that and about the goals that they and their teachers have set for their future learning.

Christmas Performance

We hope you enjoyed our christmas performance of 'A Canadian Christmas Vacation'. The show, which was written by our grade 7 students, loosely followed the National Lampoon movie 'A Christmas Vacation'. All our students and staff worked hard to put the show together. Thanks to our lead teachers Mrs. Calder, Mrs. Klassen and Mrs. Cougle, also thank you to Mrs. Masters who came back and worked with our singing groups and to Amie Calder who came in and played the piano for several of our classes. It was a great performance and a wonderful opportunity for our students to shine.
